PACS EKYC User Manual

- ➔ On the request of PACS, GSWS department has developed EKYC module for authenticating all PACS customers.
- ➔ The module is available in All secretariat employees' login in GSWS Employee Mobile Application.
- ➔ All the GSWS employees are requested to complete the above EKYC authentication.

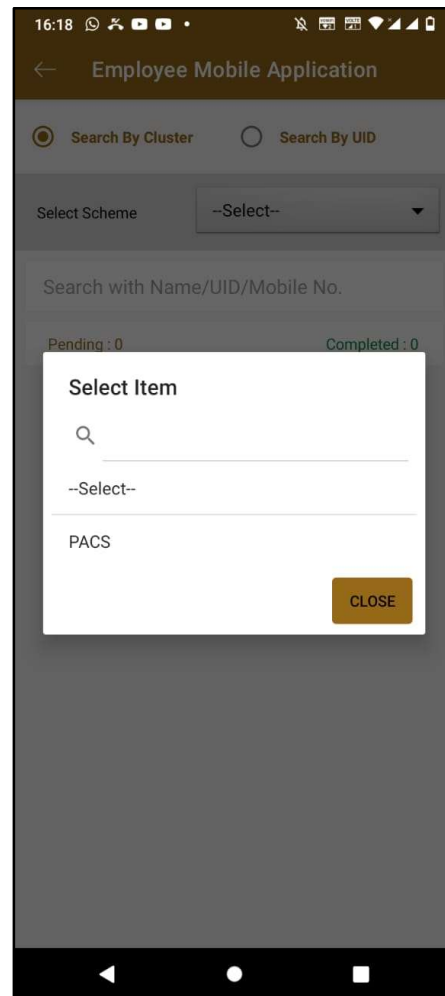
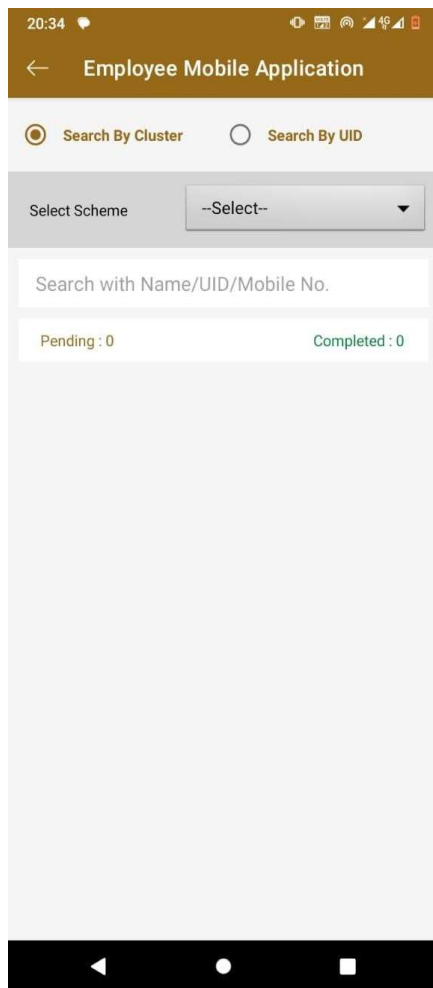


- ➔ The employee needs to login with user credentials and then click login.
- ➔ After clicking upon the login button authentication page appears, here the employee need to choose either Biometric, IRIS, or Facial Authentication.

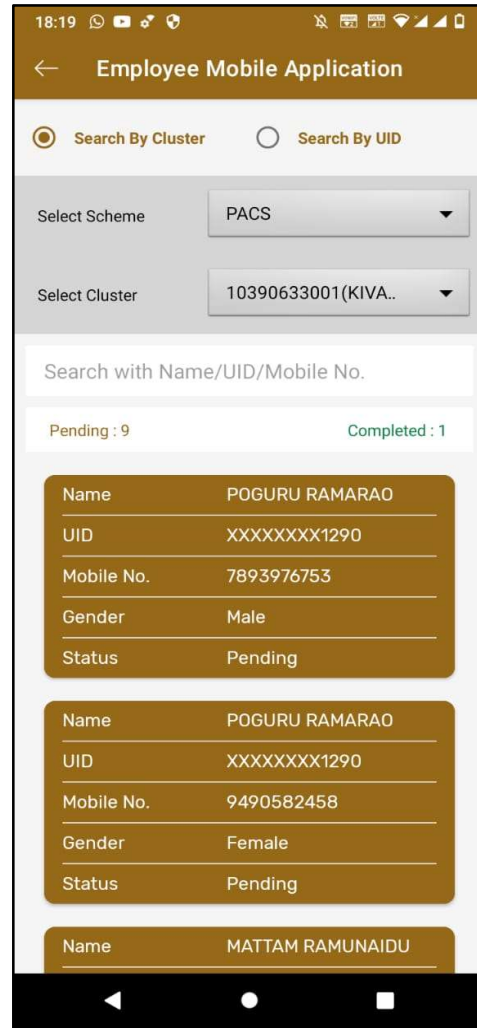
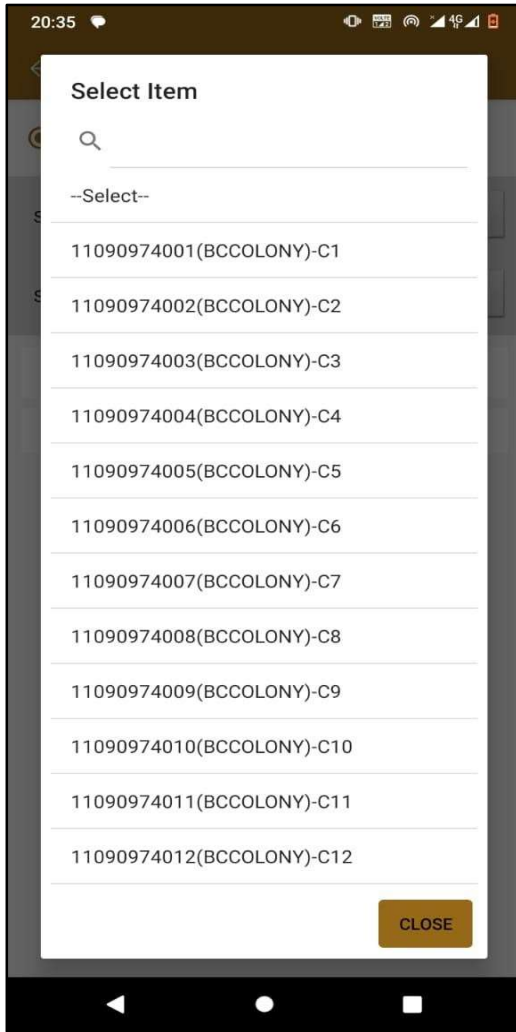


➔ After the successful authentication, the page appears as shown above. then the employee needs to click on the OTHERS EKYC.

PACS EKYC:



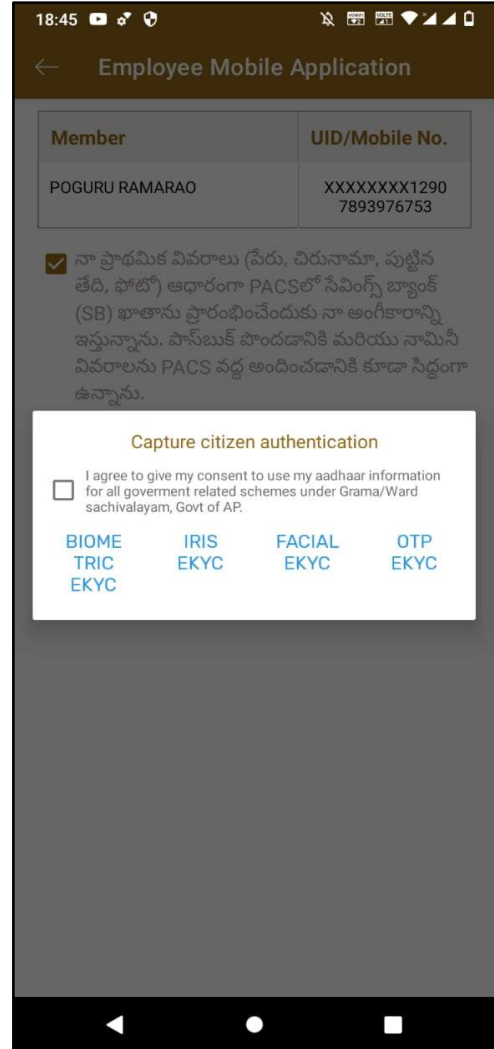
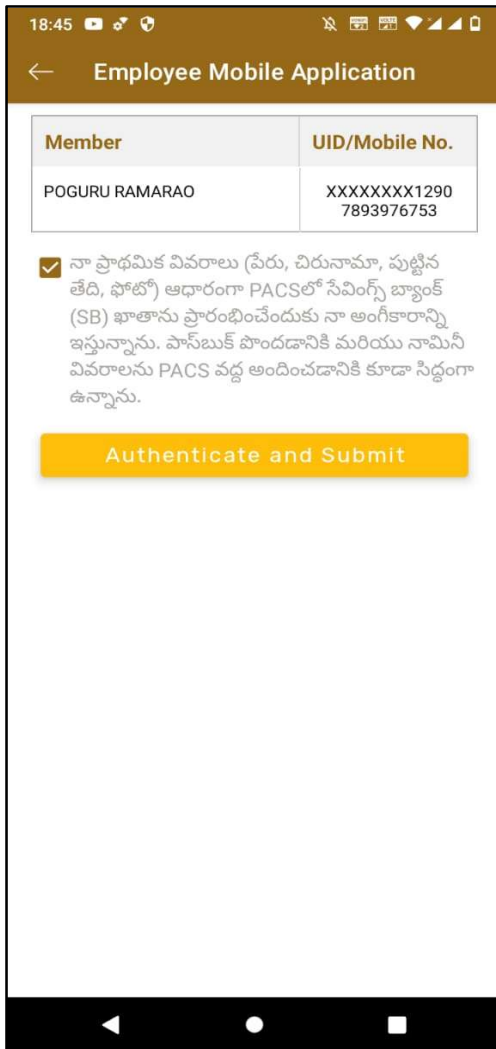
➔ Here employee need to click on the 'Select Scheme' and select the PACS from the dropdown menu.



➔ After selecting a PACS, then the user needs to select the cluster from the dropdown menu.

➔ Upon selection of the cluster, the list of names will be displayed as shown in above screen.

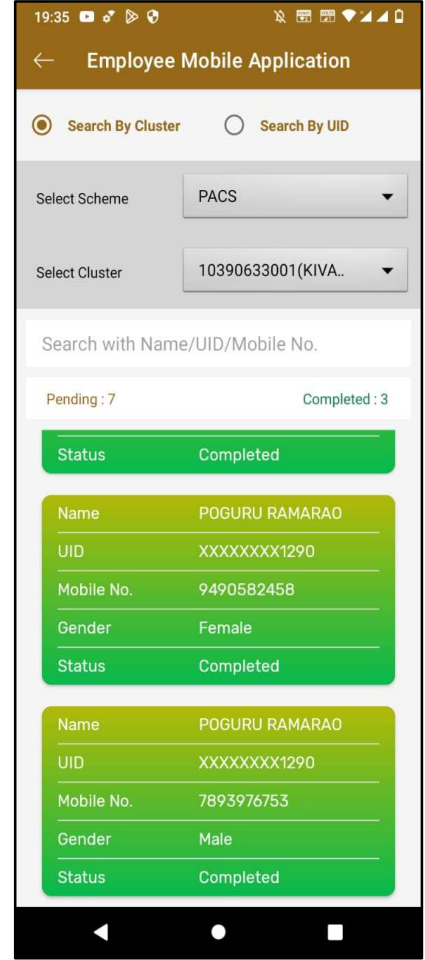
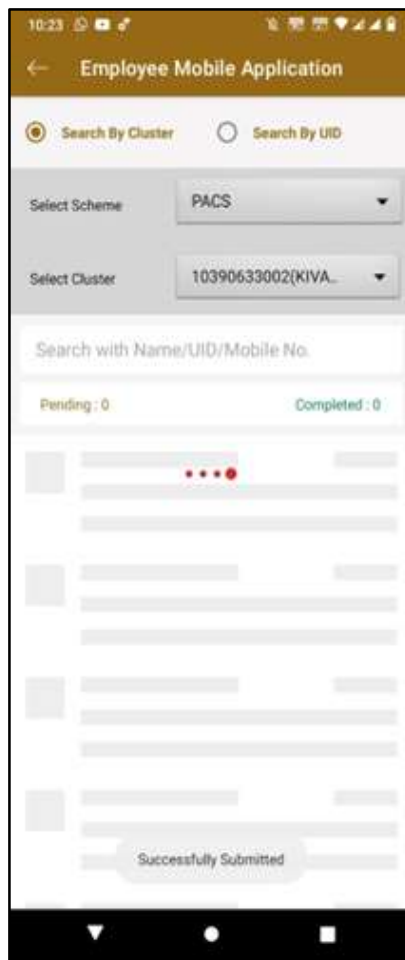
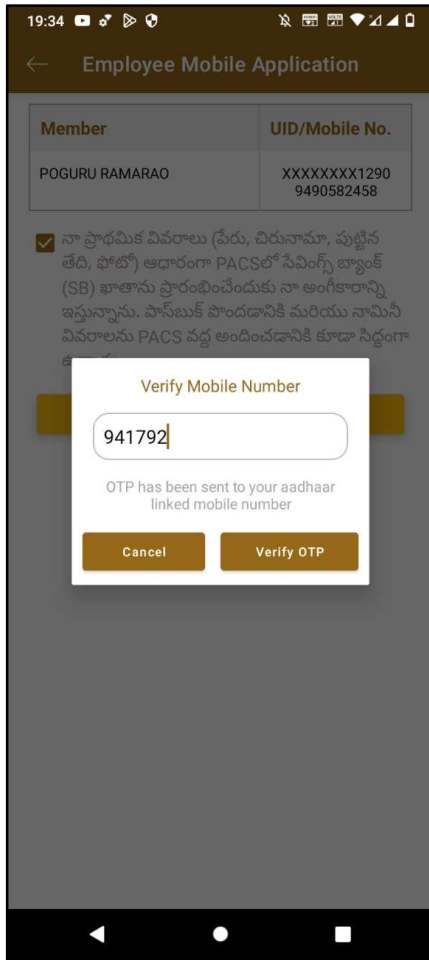
➔ Here the user can select any one of the citizen names to whom they desire to capture the EKYC.



➔ After selecting a citizen's name, then the user needs to select the consent check box (Not Mandatory) then click Authentication and Submit button.

➔ Here user needs to click on the Aadhar consent check box then click on the available option as shown in above to authenticate.

➔ Click on OTP EKYC.



- ➔ After clicking on the OTP EKYC option, then the OTP will receive on the citizen's Aadhar-linked mobile number.
- ➔ Enter OTP and Click on Verify OTP then the data will be submitted as shown in above screen 2.
- ➔ **Once the Authentication is completed the status of the household will turn into green and status will be updated as the completed.**
